## Important Instructions: Please Read

The PTG is once again pleased to sponsor SantaLand, and it's time for our young shoppers to prepare to shop for family members, friends and even pets. After you complete just a few short steps, your child(ren) will be ready for their shopping experience.

**1.** Complete the attached shopping budget envelope indicating for whom the child will shop and the budget amount for each person. Please add any category you don't see on the envelope, such as aunt/uncle, special friend, cousin, pet, etc. (See the sample envelope below.) While gifts range from 25 cents to \$8.00,\* the majority of the choices fall between \$1.00 and \$6.00. (This year we wanted to provide a few nicer sports-related and mom-type gift options in the \$7-8 range for older students who may only buy one or two special gifts.) If your child is permitted to buy a small treat for him/herself at the Sweet Shoppe, please indicate the budget amount on the envelope. All treats will be nut-free and will include items such as, cookies, brownies, cupcakes or candy. Prices will range from 25 cents to \$1.00.

**2.** Total the budget and enclose the exact amount of cash (cash only; please do not enclose a check.) in your child's envelope. Please remember to seal the envelope. **3.** Check the schedule below and send the envelope with your child(ren) on their designated shopping day.

Volunteers will assist the students with their shopping experience, and will indicate on the envelope the actual amount spent on each gift recipient. Any remaining money will be returned in the envelope.
