SERIES: Allows you to participate in several sessions around a specific area of interest or theme as an individual or with a group of friends.

EVENTS: There are literally hundreds of workshops, field trips and activities to fill your free time. If the regular schedule of troops don't work for you, don't worry you can pick and choose among the many events that Girl Scouts offer to find those that interest you. Don't want to go alone? Just grab a friend or two and get going.

CAMP: Your pathway in Girl Scouting can include outdoor challenges, nature and environmental activities, or summer resident or day camp experiences. Outdoor and camp opportunities are available year round and can be enjoyed as an individual or with a group of friends or as a troop.

TRAVEL: Got the travel bug? Girl Scouting offers great ways to begin planning your adventure! You can participate in travel locally, nationally and internationally through Girl Scouting. You can strike out on your own or travel with a group of friends.

TROOP: Want to make new friends and have great adult role models and mentors? The troop pathway provides girls within the same community, school or school district the opportunities to pool their ideas and financial resources together for a shared Girl Scout experience. Girls work together to complete Girl Scout Journeys, badge programs, plan outings and community service projects, learn new skills, and take action in their community.
